California Proposition 65 Compliance Statement (Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986)

Proposition 65 was enacted as a ballot initiative in November 1986. Under Proposition 65, manufactures are required to provide a warning if product could expose people to chemicals determined by the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects, and reproductive harm.

Proposition 65 requires that business marketing products in California provide fair and reasonable warnings unless the exposure level from the product is low enough to qualify for a conservative “safe harbor” level which is defined by the regulatory agency for each listed chemical. There is no certain way for a manufacture to know whether a product qualifies for the “safe harbor” because it is not a content-based standard.

Metaphase Technology Inc. has instituting a companywide policy to label all products that are shipped to or sold to consumers in California with the required Proposition 65 warning language. There are approximately 900 chemicals listed on Proposition 65 with more being added on a regular basis. Some of Metaphase Technology Inc. may contain one or more of the chemicals listed. For example, brass, rubber, and most machined metal parts have small amounts of the listed chemicals in them. Metaphase Technology Inc has determined that conducting the necessary testing to certify exposure levels are within Proposition 65 “safe harbor” on all products would be costly, uncertain, time consuming, and difficult.

Because we cannot be certain of the destination of components we produce, Metaphase Technology Inc will be implementing a policy of placing warning labels on all products shipped to ensure compliance with the California Law
